We had a great turnout for the Taco Dinner but the turnout for the Breakfast was a little light. This was probably due to the Broncos having their first football game starting at 11 AM on Sunday. The following excerpts came from the September business meeting minutes, which were sent to me by Tom DeClue:

The Grand Knight read applications for two transfers - James Anderson from Council 7520 and Richard French from Council 4636 in Security. A motion was made and approved to accept the two transfer requests.

A modernized 1st Degree Ceremonial is expected to be available in print in the near future. A new 1st Degree team is being assembled with Jeff Maschler as GK, Dave Miller as DGK, Joe McGirr as Warden, Gary Ware as Financial Secretary and Brian Livie as Chancellor.

Rod checked the Pennies from Heaven container on 30 July and counted \$67. This was based on about 6 weeks of donations. Further discussion is needed to decide on an appropriate use of these funds.

The annual clergy and religious dinner is at 6pm on September 26th. We are sponsoring Father's Mike, Fritz Lang and Gerry Borer at a cost of \$90. St. Paul Council 11634 is sponsoring the dinner. The notice requested each council donate an additional \$30 to cover the cost of un-sponsored attendees. A motion was made and approved to pay the additional \$30.

Pancake Breakfast collected \$580 and had \$236.14 in expenses for a net of \$343.86. Taco Dinner served 102 people and netted \$178 plus \$75 for dessert and \$16 for alcohol. Jeff Maschler recommended planned expense increase \$20, (from \$115 to \$135) to pay for the increase in food being served due to the average larger turnouts.

Following discussion, a motion was made to donate \$200 or 51%, whichever is less to Andy Perroni for

his Boy Scout Eagle project. The motion passed with one no vote.

A motion was made by Leon Hunt to donate \$100 to the Vialpando family to help defer funeral expenses for their Son. The motion passed.
